### February Lady Sweater KAL Notes by Carol Hurt

One row buttonhole – <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=EY4vBzLo-Xs>

**ONE ROW BUTTONHOLE**- Copyright, Carol Hurt 2010

YF and slip 1 st purl-wise, YB

\*SL next stitch, purl-wise, from LH needle to RH needle

BO 1 stitch\* - repeat (usually 3 stitches is good)

Slip stitch on RH needle over to LH needle

Turn work – yarn to back

Cable CO same amount you bound off.....

NOW draw yarn thru next st for the last cast-on stitch, BUT YF first (between needle points),

then place on LH needle.

You have now cast on one more than you bound off.

Turn, slip one stitch to right hand needle and bind off this last stitch.

Continue in pattern across row.

e-wrap cast on – cast on 10% less stitches. When knitting back across cast on stitches there will be excess yarn – do backwards loops for your remaining 10% of stitches.

For gradual shaping – go up a needle size after knitting about 1/3 of lace section (body) and increase needle size again when around 2/3 of body completed. You can also decrease a needle size on sleeves near elbow.
